Ryde's 135th Anniversary Celebrations Update

Your hard-working committee is putting together an amazing roster of events and attractions for our August 16th date. Put it on your calendar now, and invite your friends and family. heritage properties through Town Council. This would involve a by-law to designate them, and they would receive a plaque. Jeremy Rand, of the Town's planning department, states that a heritage by-law would not necessarily affect what you can do with a property. The By-law would recognize certain features of a building (or in some cases a landscape), which need Council's approval before being altered. If a property is designated and an addition, alteration or construction takes place that would not affect the protected features, a building permit would easily be obtained. 


Wild Game Dinner - Wow!




Free Gentle Fitness Classes Coming to Ryde!
