Ryde Involvement with Green Energy Project

As some of you may know, a presentation by a company called *Rising Sun Community Power Corp* was recently made to the Ryde Co-op. *Rising Sun* is a company headed up by Jonathan Godfrey and his father Sheldon Godfrey. They have asked the Ryde Co-op to participate in a green energy solar project. This win-win arrangement gives *Rising Sun* a higher probability of the application getting government approval because the point system in the application process favours co-operatives. The co-op assumes a 15% interest in two of *Rising Sun's* Muskoka Green Energy projects under the FIT Rules. Also Ryde shall have no responsibility for contributing any funds to *Rising Sun* for any reason whatsoever, apart from its share subscription, and will have no liability.

At a general meeting held December 19, 2012 the co-op members voted to move ahead with participation in this project and sign a letter of intent and to review the business plan that will be delivered to the co-op by February 15, 2013. The business plan must be to the satisfaction of The Ryde Community Co-op.

Rising Sun has applied to the Ontario Power Authority for approval of two "Green Energy" "small FIT" projects in the District of Muskoka (projects in the Huntsville area)

We will be bringing you more information on this project as we move forward in the new year.


