Fresh Food Baskets

You may have read about the food box program that the District of Muskoka is running. These boxes feature fresh produce and are available monthly for only \$20. For example, the February basket contained spinach, leaf lettuce, iceberg lettuce, oranges, bananas, oranges, bananas, strawberries, broccoli, cauliflower, baby

carrots, lemons, mushrooms, red cabbage, cantaloupe, tomatoes, a five-pound bag of potatoes and Four Season Greens Pea shoots. We are looking at running this program from the co-op. We would need at least 10 families to sign up. (You can sign up for more than one box) As well, we would need a couple of committed volunteers to facilitate the program.
