The field is now open for up to 10 contestants to compete for the title of Ryde Chili Champ 2010. Please contact Arleigh Luckett to register in the category of Traditional Chili or Creative Chili.

Traditional Chili features meat (or vegetarian alternative), beans, tomato and your secret combination of spices and other flavourings. Creative Chili goes beyond the basics to include less usual and sometimes surprising additions. Entrants must register by January 4, 2010. Arleigh would also like to hear from several volunteers who would like to show

case a favourite corn bread, salad or dessert recipe.

Admission is \$7.00 per person. Proceeds will be donated to the Salvation Army Food Bank in Gravenhurst.

How to enter the 3rd Annual Chili Cook-off:

- Decide whether you are entering the Traditional Chili or Creative Chili category

- 5. Join your family, friends and neighbours for an evening of fun and good food. ❖
