This month's recipe comes from Cheryl Cooper, and was a hit at the Ladies' Luncheon:

Green Beans and Meat Balls Casserole:

Mix together: I can Cream of Mushroom Soup 3/4 C. milk

Butter the bottom and sides of a 6-serving casserole dish. Spoon in soup/milk mixture to just cover the bottom. Add: (in layers) 30-32 meatballs (make your own or use a box of frozen ones)

green beans (2 cans, drained) I can mandarin oranges or pineapple chunks, drained (optional) Rest of soup/milk mixture.

Top: Crumble enough crackers or potato chips to cover the top evenly.

Bake: uncovered, in a 350 degrees oven for 45 minutes.

Cheryl suggests serving with baked or mashed potatoes, beets or corn, and a salad.
