Did you Know?

One of Ontario's newest parks, Queen Elizabeth II Wildlands Provincial Park, which covers a total of 33,505 hectares (335 square kilometers, or almost 83,000 acres), occupies much of the southeast portion of the geographic Township of Ryde. It is a Natural Environment Class Park, and also has lands in the geographic Townships of Dalton and Digby, and in the geographic Townships of Anson and Lutterworth. There are no other protected areas in southern Ontario that are of the size and quality of this Park. The biologically significant Lewisham Wetland, and the Riley Lake Barrens are in the Ryde portion of the Park.

Incorporation was required to secure funding, with the purpose of fostering social and economic development for the betterment of the community. The Ryde Community Centre Building is owned by Trillium

Lakelands District School Board, leased to the Town of Gravenhurst. The Ryder Newsletter is distributed to 345 households on RR3 Gravenhurst, and to members who have a different mailing address.
