The Summerland General Store at the corner of Houseys Rapids and Riley Lake Roads is open for business again. New owners Carrie Marriott and Ron Post (pictured, at right) welcomed patrons and well wishers to their Grand Opening on Saturday, July 18. The gas pumps are gone but they've added some new services such as a propane tank exchange program. A suggestion box by the front door demonstrates their eagerness to meet local needs.

Ron has been coming to this area since he was a child. He built a cottage on Riley Lake in 1984 and became a full time resident six years later. Carrie is a more recent arrival, having moved up to Riley Lake from an apartment on Lake Couchiching in the spring of 2008.



Together they plan to keep the store open seven days a week, 363 days a year. (They do plan to close on Christmas and Boxing Day). Store hours are 7-7 Monday through Thursday, 7-9 Friday, 8-7 Saturday and 9-6 Sunday.

Community Access Program Computers Have Moved!

The Board of Directors of the Ryde Community Co-op have approved a plan to move the two Community Access Program (CAP) computers from the community centre to the Summerland General Store in an effort to provide better access for users and make the program self-supporting.

The computers are now at Summerland and are available for use by the public whenever the store is open. Users will be required to sign in and out and pay a nominal fee for the time they use the computer.

Recent changes to the funding and sponsorship for the program made the Co-op responsible for the cost of the Internet service. The Board approved a one year trial period to evaluate costs associated with the program and the benefits to the community.
