

### Health & Wellness Series

On May I, Dr. Kelly McIntosh of Gravenhurst Chiropractic Centre and her companion "Mr. Bones" kept everyone engaged and involved with her knowledge of the spine and its function is maintaining health. She gave suggestions for exercises, lifting, posture, and footwear, and concluded her talk with

information and a demonstration of therapeutic acupuncture.

Acupuncture involves the insertion of extremely thin needles to various depths at strategic points on the body. The procedure originated in China thousands of years ago, but over the past two decades its popularity has grown

significantly within Canada. Studies indicate that it may provide a number of health benefits

— from reducing pain to helping with pregnancy-induced nausea. The health session was followed by a delicious lunch and a social time.

Next up: on Thursday June 5th at 10am at the Ryde Community Centre, Wendy Earle ("The lonic Woman") will present a demonstration of her Detox Footbath: a footbath tub is filled with clean water and sea salt, which is high in mineral content, is added. An array unit is placed in the water, which results in positive and negatively charged ions being circulated through the body of the therapy subject. The clean water changes colour, which is due, it is claimed, to ionization and the resulting oxidation of the minerals in the water, plus the release of toxins from the body.
