But first were presentations — Arleigh Luckett presented Mayor Klinck with a donation to the town to assist with the upkeep of the Community Centre and to express appreciation for their ongoing support. Mayor Klinck, in response, brought the Chain of Office to show those in attendance and began by placing it around Arleigh's neck. It was then passed around for all to have a good look.

The second presentation was by a representative of the Ontario Winter Games 2010 with a final report of the games, lots of very positive comments for Gravenhurst and a framed copy of a set of medals from the games. Other delegations were people from the Fine Films group using the Opera House and there was a proposal for a coffee bar in the new municipal offices.

It is a living and growing venue, a place where the curators Lightman and O'Callaghan set very flexible boundaries within which the invited artists explore and create site-specific work. afterLandscape is an exhibition where four artists Penelope Stewart and Jeannie Thib (Canadian) and Australian Artists Bev Hogg and Trish Roan, were invited to explore what this landscape means to them. The artists have been selected not for their similarities but for their differences so that each takes on a particular role within the spectrum of the whole.
