Ryde Community Centre Could Be Closed

It has just been learned that the draft 2011 budget for the Town of Gravenhurst includes a proposal to "eliminate municipal participation in the Ryde School". If passed this would "return the facility back to the Trillium Lakelands School Board" thereby ending a ten year arrangement that allowed the Ryde Community Co-op to operate a Community Centre in the building.

We believe that with your support, we can show the members of council that this is not only a viable community program, it is an integral part of our community and well worth the money that is spent to keep it open.

We need you – the community of Ryde – to join together and help us keep our Community Centre going. CPR/AED Certification Course

Despite a snowy day and some challenging road conditions, participants in the CPR/AED Certification Course arrived on time and ready to go. Using the latest technology in CPR mannequins, the group members discovered how much strength and endurance it takes to administer CPR consistently on adults, children and babies.

They then learned how to correctly use an AED unit to defibrillate someone in cardiac arrest. Several different scenarios were presented for the participants to practice their skills.

AED (Automated External Defibrillator) units are becoming more readily available in public places such as arenas, community centres and schools. Having the knowledge of how to apply CPR and administer an AED unit could save a person's life.

Needle Felting Workshop

Fibre artist Tonya Meadows will be conducting an afternoon workshop on April 9th at the Ryde Community Centre. This is a beginner's workshop where you will learn how to use a barbed needle to embellish a piece of felted material using wool roving and yarns. This method of felting is a creative way for you to add an extra personal touch to knitted or felted items or even to
