A Firing Range on Merkley Road?

On September 28th, 2010, at a Public Meeting in the Gravenhurst Council Chambers, over 30 area residents opposed a request for a zoning amendment to permit a shooting range to be constructed on Fire Road A3 [at the corner where Merkley Rd. and Lewisham Rd. meet].

The Gravenhurst and District Conservation Club, represented by President, Michael White, presented a proposal to rezone 4 hectares on a 39 hectare (97 acre) parcel of land to build a 3 bench firing range. The firing benches are 50 to 200 yards away from their respective berms, and would catch stray bullets and should absorb some of the sound generated.

The Club owns 241 hectares (597 acres) and next plans to build a sporting clays range if the majority of the members want it. They also hope to provide a safe location for the OPP to train their officers. The club now has 14

members and it expects to grow, but does not want membership to exceed 100.

The club will carry insurance and conform to the standards required by the Chief Firearms Office.

Council turned down the zoning amendment request. The Conservation Club is not appealing council's decision at the OMB, as they are eligible to reapply for a zoning change on their property. It will be an ongoing concern for local property owners.

Increased noise and traffic from the proposed firing range is a concern to residents and to businesses involving horses. Hunt club owners are concerned about the loss of game. Naturalists are investigating the impact of noise and loss of habitat for wildlife that will happen with a firing range on Merkley Road. •
