Due to COVID, we will be holding a virtual meeting via Google Meet again this year. Documents will be emailed to members.

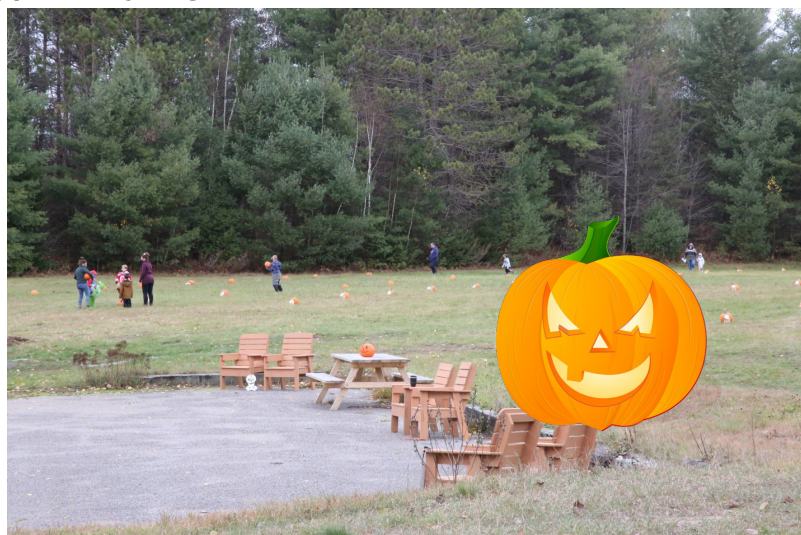
