Ryde Co-op Helps Friends of the Muskoka Watershed

The health of our lakes and sugar bushes is limited by widespread calcium decline – a legacy of decades of acid rain. Sugar maples have a particularly high demand for calcium. Friends of the Muskoka Watershed has launched a project, called AshMuskoka, to collect fireplace, wood stove and wood boiler ashes, which are 30% calcium, from hundreds of people in Muskoka and return these ashes to local sugar bushes to help solve the calcium decline problem.

You can help by bringing your clean, dry hardwood ashes to the Co-op and depositing them in the cans provided by the front door.
