# Your New RCC Board of Directors

We were very pleased to see the large turnout for the ham dinner and the AGM this past Saturday. Over 60 people came to enjoy Chef Larry and Anne's delicious dinner and then stay for the AGM.

The information shared at the AGM was not all doom and gloom about the future of the Co-op. In fact, we feel the Co-op is in the best position it could be and we feel very optimistic that the Co-op will prevail. The business plan for the Co-op provides strategies that will be used to manage the repairs and improvements that we know the building needs and outlines possible measures for generating operating funds. This business plan has been shared with the Town of Gravenhurst and the District of Muskoka.

Co-op member Morris Cooper explained the process of the original sale of the property and the successive transfers to the Trillium Lakelands District School Board. He further explained the legislation that is being used by the Province through the Ministry of Education that requires all school boards in Ontario to divest themselves of surplus properties. Morris has been in communication with Gravenhurst's CAO David Weldon, who has also been looking into options and precedents.

Our good news came from Co-op member Jonny Godfrey. You may recall that a couple of years ago, Jonny along with his father Sheldon Godfrey, came to meetings at the Co-op to request the support of the Co-op on applications for renewable energy (solar) grants. The membership voted in favour of this request and supported the four project applications. Jonny's companies have now been given government contracts for these projects and the Co-op stands to benefit financially for 20 years once the projects start producing. It was noted that these are very small projects that will be built just south of Huntsville.

Member Randy Jorgensen also presented his understanding of the status of the sale of the school and property from his perspective as our Ward 4 Councilor. It is very hard to predict what the Town's position is going to be until all the information is in and the asking price is announced.

The Ryde Board of Directors is in agreement that until this information is known, it is premature to focus on any one option. We do know that the assessment team was at the Co-op this past week and so we expect to have that information soon. In the meantime, we are continuing to gather support and promote our business plan. We have since met with Mayor Donaldson who assured us the Town will continue to work with us for a positive solution. As soon as more information is available, we will put it out to our membership.

The evening concluded with election of the 2015 – 2016 Board of Directors. The members of the 2014 – 2015 Board agreed to stand again for this coming year and were promptly re-elected along with new Member-At-Large, Janet Wilcox. We are all committed to keeping the Co-op and with your support we can do it!


