Capital Fundraising Campaign Update

We've said it before, and it continues to be astonishingly true; you can't beat the teamwork in Ryde. We have pulled together in a cohesive effort to raise funds for the upcoming loan repayments in January with a fantastic Bazaar and Lunch, an on-line auction, a Book Sale, a Bottle Drive and a special dinner! We have amazing support from businesses and friends in the area. We continue to seek out sources of revenue, including grants. We recently found out that we

have been successful in our application for a lottery license!

As shared in our member meeting on November 23^{rd} , we have raised \$16 000.00 of the \$20 557.87 due in January.

This is a one-time bump in the road for the Co-op, as once the major part of the loan is repaid, subsequent mortgage repayments will be \$5000 per year plus interest (to the Town) for the next four years.

We have a strong Board and a great Capital Building Committee in place and have excellent prospects for the future. Our successes increase our confidence that our *Ryde to the Future* will be exciting!
