We are pleased to announce that we have received a New Horizons for Seniors grant from Service Canada for \$25,000 towards our Ryde Raise the Roof project! With the funds that we have already raised, we are over half way to the quoted price for the job. As well, we have been

notified that we were successful in our application for an Enabling Accessibility Grant in the amount of \$13,800 towards replacing our brittle, cracking floor tiles. 2018 will be a big year for the Ryde Co-op.
